Disciplinary Action: UCL Men's Hockey

A complaint, against UCL Men's Hockey Club, was received by the CSSD Officer from an anonymous source, who had been given a copy of the UCLUHC "rules".

These "rules" were deemed sexist and homophobic, as well as encouraging violence towards women. A personal disciplinary was held against the President and Treasurer for allowing this to happen within the club, and the result of that was as follows:

Both Officers were banned from all Union events and premises (sports grounds, including Old Cranleighans, the union buildings, union events such as Vodpop etc), with a special allowance of access to the Rights and Advice Centre with prior arrangement through the Chief Executive.

It was also suggested that the club be disciplined and the Disciplinary Panel recommended to Activities Board that it forced all teams to accept a forfeit on their next matches. Activities Board endorsed this recommendation and a walkover was given to the opponents of all three UCL Men's teams.

Film Licensing

As of 1 February UCL has purchased a Public Video Screening (PVS) License for UCL main campus. The PVS Licence permits UCL to show films in public for no charge to fixed audiences. Under the terms of the PVS licence it is the licensees' responsibility to obtain physical copies of any films you wish to screen - on VHS video or DVD from legitimate retail or rental outlets in the UK.

It is a fundamental term of the PVS license that no charge is made directly or indirectly for the screening. Promotion of the screening is allowed only in very limited circumstances and it is not permitted to use a screening to promote or endorse any other goods or services.

It is a requirement of the licence that UCL has to report which films have been shown quarterly therefore if you wish to show a film, you must notify us in advance by the President completing a Notification of a Club & Society Film Showing form - available from the CSC - and sign to agree with the terms of the licence.

This must be completed at least 2 weeks before the showing.

Access to C&S Finance Assistant 5 Days a Week

Club & Societies(C&S) can now see the C&S Finance Assistant in **specified hours 5 days a week**. Finance currently provide 2 "appointment only" surgeries and Finance will be adding 3 "drop in" surgeries.

The increased volume of work means Club & Societies **cannot be seen** outside these times.
